- ❖ 204 companies in the wood processing industry were interviewed by questionnaire.
- return questionnaires was 63 %

Figure 1._Ownership certificates of QMS in wood processing enterprises in Slovakia




Figure 2.Ownership certification marks in the wood processing enterprises in Slovakia




Figure 3. Benefits from the implementation of QMS in the wood processing enterprises in Slovakia




Figure 4.Negative experiences from the implementation of QMS in wood processing enterprises in Slovakia




Figure 5. Reasons for the implementation of QMS in the wood processing enterprises in Slovakia





Figure 6. The time required for the implementation of QMS in place in the wood processing enterprises in Slovakia
