
Aim

- literature review on supply chain management.






Output - five initiatives

- Five groups of initiatives for innovation were identified, taking into account the answers of majority of 196 entrepreneurs from both Bulgaria and Macedonia and statistical survey of 1943 enterprises.
- The initiatives are addressing entrepreneurs, the state, and e-services developers.
- The later include network development, e-consultancy and e-education services development.




Implementation of results of the research:




Database of companies - better connectivity along the supply chain
