

WoodEMA, i.a. "Roy Damary" fund for young scientists scholarship

CRITERIA

These are the criteria for giving the WoodEMA, i.a. "Roy Damary" fund for young scientists scholarship to young scientists whose scientific contribution to development of WoodEMA international association, and to science, according to WoodEMA, i.a. Executive Board evaluation, is significant.

Candidates younger than 35 can apply for the scholarship each year, and they can be awarded only once in 3 years.

Each candidate have to put all the data according to given criteria in his/her application, and those data have to be verifiable in WoodEMA Best practice data base.

Evaluation criteria

1. Years of age up to 35 on the deadline of application

2. Number of journal articles in last 5 years

5. Project summary suggested for funding by Roy Damary fund

The scholarship given by WoodEMA, i.a. will be in amount of 500 €.

If two or more applicants have the same total of points, scholarship will be given to applicant with the highest number of points in Criteria 1. If that number of points is the same, the scholarship will be given to applicant with highest number of points in Criteria 2. If that number of points is also the same, the scholarship in the same amount of $500 \in \text{will}$ be given to both (all) applicants with the same number of points in total and in Criteria 1 and 2.

Young researcher who receives the "Roy Damary" schoolarhip have to use it within 2 years from the date he/she receives it.

The "Roy Damary" scholarship have to be used on some other international scientific conference (WoodEMA conferences are not included) or other scientific activities.

To confirm the use of scholarship, the person who received it, after the conference has to provide evidence in the form of Book of proceedings (in pdf), where the article with Acknowledgement to WoodEMA, i.a. "Roy Damary" fund is placed, the programme of the conference where it is clear that he/she actively participated with a presentation or a poster and at least 1 proof of payment (participation fee, accommodation, trip expences, publishing fee for a scientific journal).
